Remember the three R's--*Reduce, Reuse and Recycle*. Mixed waste is the most costly way of disposing of our garbage. Every time we move something from the regular trash into the recycling bin or home compost pile, we help save money and resources.

The Department of Public Works will pick up all recyclables (paper, cardboard, plastic and cans) every Wednesday. Recycling bins are available from the Village at a cost of \$26.
