Remember the three R's--**Reduce, Reuse and Recycle**. Mixed waste is the most costly way of disposing of our garbage. Every time we move something from the regular trash into the recycling bin or home compost pile, we help save money and resources.

The Department of Public Works will pick up all recyclables (paper, cardboard, plastic and cans) every Wednesday. Recycling bins are available from the Village at a cost of \$26.

All Bellport residents can use the residential drop off facility at the Brookhaven Town Landfill's Household Hazardous Waste or STOP (Stop Throwing Out Pollutants) facility. It is of the utmost importance that we keep motor oil, antifreeze, pesticides, paint removers, etc., out of our groundwater and bay.
