











RECYCLING IN BELLPORT 2026

Remember the three R's--**Reduce, Reuse and Recycle**. Mixed waste is the most costly way of disposing of our garbage. Every time we move something from the regular trash into the recycling bin or home compost pile, we help save money and resources.

The Department of Public Works will pick up all recyclables (paper, cardboard, plastic and cans) every Wednesday. Recycling bins are available from the Village at a cost of \$30.

GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS ARE NO LONGER ACCEPTED WITH YOUR RECYCLABLES. You may place in your regular garbage or drop off free of charge at Brookhaven Landfill Resident Drop on Horseblock Road.

All Bellport residents can use the residential drop off facility at the Brookhaven Town Landfill's Household Hazardous Waste or STOP (Stop Throwing Out Pollutants) facility. It is of the utmost importance that we keep motor oil, antifreeze, pesticides, paint removers, etc., out of our groundwater and bay. RESIDENTIAL SANITATION and DEBRIS RULES & POLICIES

The Department of Public Works collects residential household garbage twice a week (except on certain holidays). Recyclables are collected on Wednesdays. See the back of this pamphlet for list of items to be recycled.

Household garbage should be placed at the curb no earlier than 6 pm the night before pick-up and must be out no later than 6:30 am on the day of pick up. Cans are to be removed no later than 9 pm the night of pick up. No containers shall remain at the curb for more than 27 hours.

Latex paint can be put out with your regular garbage. Oil based paint must be brought to the Town of Brookhaven Landfill on Horseblock Road. The Village will not accept batteries, asbestos, tires or demolition and construction materials.

Plastic containers numbered 1, 2 and 5, aluminum, tin & steel cans as well as clean paper and cardboard can be recycled. It is necessary to keep paper and cardboard separate from other recyclables. Please see the diagram on the back cover.

OVERSIZED ITEMS

Residents may place one bulk item, i.e., couches, tables, refrigerators (doors removed), etc., at the curb on your regular garbage day. Please note that in most situations, a separate truck will come by to pick up.

DEMOLITION and CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

The Village will only accept demolition and construction debris if:

- A dumpster is obtained from Village Hall (631-286-0327) at the cost of \$90 per dump
- The materials originate within the Village
- There is no concrete, asphalt shingles or other very heavy materials included. These materials will not be accepted

GRASS, LEAVES, BRUSH and BRANCHES

Leaves may be left in the street for pick up from **October 15th through December 20th**. Leaves must be bagged at all other times. Brush and branches must be cut in lengths not greater than 4 feet, tied and bundled.

The Village does not pick up grass clippings and for many years, has encouraged backyard home composting of yard waste and kitchen scraps.

GARBAGE CAN REGULATIONS

- One stop per household
- All household garbage (waste) must be placed in a garbage bag then put in a can, covered with a lid and placed at the curb of the nearest Village owned street. Loose garbage placed in cans will not be picked up. The Public Works Superintendent may approve alternative garbage can locations.
- A garbage can may be no larger than 32 gallons and cannot weigh more than 40 pounds. No more than 4 garbage cans may be placed at the curb at any one time.
