STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Village of Bellport, New York for a period of time beginning Friday, September 25, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. and continuing in effect through Tuesday, September 29, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. unless sooner rescinded or extended.

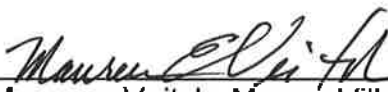
The State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions produced by:

A NOR'EASTER WITH HAZARDOUS COASTAL CONDITIONS, STRONG NORTHEAST WINDS, HIGH SURF, ELEVATED TIDES, COASTAL FLOODING, SIGNIFICANT BEACH EROSION, DOWN TREES/BRANCHES, AND HEAVY RAINFALL THROUGH SUNDAY EVENING, SEPTEMBER 27, 2026.

As a result of the ongoing storm, the Village is experiencing flooding, coastal erosion, downed trees/branches. Some roadways in the Village are obstructed and some area residents are without power. Such conditions threaten and/or imperil the public safety of the citizens of the Village of Bellport.

As Chief Executive of this municipality, I have exercised the authority given to me under New York State Executive Law, Article 2-B, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the community.

I hereby direct the Department of Public Works to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary. Individuals should avoid PARKING on residential streets to allow for more rapid, effective debris removal, emergency vehicle access, and to ensure public safety during these conditions.
